Junior Position in Public Economics

(75% TV-L E13)

The Chair of Public Finance at FAU Erlangen-Nuremberg announces a junior position as of March 1, 2019 or later.

Applicants should have a completed Master's degree in economics (or should be close to completion) with a focus on quantitative methods as well as public economics or microeconomics. Fluent English skills are required, and German would be an asset. Fields of responsibility include participation in ongoing research and teaching.

The Chair and the Institute for Economics provide an active and lively research environment. Your PhD and your participation in the PhD program of the School of Business and Economics is strongly encouraged. Participation in third-party funded research is welcome.

The Chair's team focuses on research in public economics. Current research projects deal with microdata analysis of public policy, including taxation and subsidies, as well as with inter-jurisdictional competition and issues of fiscal policy.

Salary corresponds to the German pay scale. The appointment is initially limited for a period of two years but can be extended for up to three additional years. Options are available also for the time after the PhD.

Women are strongly encouraged to apply. Disabled applicants will be preferred when equally qualified.
